

HOW TO CONNECT TO WEBMAIL TO RECEIVE SHA EMAIL

You are required to maintain acceptable Security levels on the devices used to connect to email. This includes your Operating System being up-to-date, current Virus Scan software and not connecting to your email from public (internet café) or untrusted computers.

Please refer to the table below to find your Domain, Server Address and User Name (computer login name) format according to the former Health Regions.
